## GUIDELINES FOR THE MEMBERS OF SUB-COMMITTEES

- The sub committee members must work with **Love and Humility, respecting the Senior members** of the Organization. They must work as a team with unity in their districts.
- The sub-committees are formed to assist the District Organization (District President, District Coordinators, Samithi Conveners) so as to create a new generation of active workers.
- Sub-committee members must support the DP with ideas, content and help in pooling up the man power and resources and must work in the group sincerely and they must win the hearts of the people with loving and supporting nature.
- District President must feel that they are morally supported by the sub-committee members.
- **The DPs must call a meeting of the nominated members of each sub committees in their districts and nominate 3 to 5 members (below 40 years) for those sub committees before 31<sup>st</sup> Dec, 2013 and take the assistance of this team for fulfilling the activities or targets of each sub committee.**

Submit the same to the Convener of respective sub committees.

- Members of the sub committees must be in regular contact with the **members of the other sub committees** (Cultural, Service, Spiritual, Balvikas and Public Awareness) in their respective districts.
- It is the responsibility of the District President and the District co-coordinators in achieving the targets as specified in the action plan by involving respective sub-committee members.
- The sub-committees shall meet once in **4 months at state level separately and report the progress to the State President.**
- At district level, the respective sub-committee members (Spiritual, Cultural, Service, Balavikas and Public Awareness) **will meet once in two month** to review the programs in the district as per the action plan and report the same to the respective convenors of the sub-committees.

## **MINUTES OF THE STATE CULTURAL SUB COMMITTEE MEETING**

**Sunday, 20<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2013 Prema Sadan, Visakhapatnam**

- The meeting started at 10am with Jyothi Prajwalana by the State President and other dignitaries.
- The meeting was presided over by Sri S.G.Chalam, State President.
- Sri D.Raghava Rao, District sevadal coordinator, Visakhapatnam and sub committee members welcomed the members present.
- At the outset, the State President expressed his happiness at the first meeting of the State sub-committee for Bhajans & Cultural activities. He started with the action plan for the years 2013-2015 given in the booklet and emphasized that the sub committee members should work hard in getting the plan implemented in all the Districts. He desired that all the members of sub committee should attend all the meetings meant for them without fail which would help to achieve the expected results.
- Sri M.S.Prakasa Rao, State co-ordinator for Bhajans & Cultural activities has given detailed brochure on the action plan and explained in detail on each activity with Power Point presentation.
- It is suggested to formulate a committee in each district considering not more than 5 members in consultation with the District Presidents concerned. The committee would concentrate exclusively on this subject. The sub committee and the zonal coordinators shall submit reports periodically on the progress of implementation of the plan to the state coordinator & convener of the cultural sub-committee Sri M.S.Prakasa Rao who works in turn submit a consolidated report to the State President.
- Bhajan workshops and Training camps for Bhajan Trainers should invariably be conducted at Samithi level and the state coordinator shall depute teams to facilitate conduction of workshops and camps. The District Presidents are requested to inform the venue and date in advance to the State Coordinator. 5 singers who can sing well may be identified and selected by the District and they

will be trained by the team. It is also suggested to conduct one sadhana camp for singers once in 6 months at District / Samithi level. Public Bhajan may be conducted minimum at two places like Temples, community halls, Educational institutions etc on special occasions. Outsiders / non-devotees can be invited to get them trained to sing in our Bhajans.

- Exhibitions may be conducted with flexes, charts depicting the importance of Namasmarana and Swamy's preachings etc., at outside areas and public places for at least 3 days. Wide publicity shall be given with special intimation to the schools and colleges.
- Cultural Programmes and play-lets: It is suggested to start with Bhajan in each cultural programme. Local persons associated with the cultural matters, even devotees/non devotees can be involved In our cultural activities. In order to conduct Dramas / Play-lets effectively and for selections of actors, Balavikas Gurus and spiritual coordinators can be contacted. It is suggested to identify local experts and old artists of that District and felicitate them during the drama festivals. We can conduct workshops to impart training to youth and Balavikas Gurus to organize drama/Play-let activities. **The workshop would be conducted on 22-12-2013 at Sivam, Hyderabad.** The State coordinator stated that for conducting exhibitions and organizing cultural activities relevant scripts, audio and video CDs are available with him and District Presidents and committee members can make use of them.
- To facilitate the sub committee members for easy / proper implementation of action plan, the following members are nominated at Zonal level and District level as in charges.
- The District Presidents are requested to inform them about their nomination with **Xerox copy of the minutes.**

## **MINUTES OF THE STATE PUBLIC ACTIVITIES SUB COMMITTEE MEETING** **Sunday, 1<sup>st</sup> Dec, 2013 at Hyderabad**

On 1<sup>st</sup> Dec 2013 the State level committee members have met in Eswaramma Seva Sadan (Shivam) Hyderabad and discussed various plans to be implemented in the districts to spread the universal message of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba. The participants have taken active role in supporting the action plans with various inputs. To further take the proceedings to the district level and facilitate the implementation and follow up at primary, secondary and tertiary levels the following State Committee members have been allotted with the responsibility of various districts.

It is responsibility of the District President and his team to fulfil the activities as in the action plan, the sub-committee members are to assist and the district organisation can make use of their knowledge, expertise.

1. The following activities are categorized as one set:  
Seminars, Symposia, Work shops, Talk shows, Discussions etc. Talk shows and discussions can be considered as one programme.
2. Hoardings/caricatures for public display (including cars/two wheelers) shall be decided at the state level to ensure uniformity. Simple sayings of Bhagawan and extracts from 'Chinna Katha' have been suggested. Design of these display material will be finalised before the end of this month.
3. 'Thought for the day' can be displayed in the lifts/corporate offices, with suitable permission.
4. Exhibitions can be arranged in own/hired premises. Proper standards are to be maintained regarding the material under display.
5. Exhibitions & book fairs can be considered under one category.  
Books regarding all religions should be made available. Only selected books should be displayed or kept in the libraries of colleges.
6. Sarva Dharma emblem of specific size and quality to be prepared and displayed.
7. Service activities are to be got presented by the media as news item and not as advertisement.
8. Dedicated columns on the same page may be obtained in particular newspapers to gain regular attention by readers.

9. Scrolling/telecast of videos may be tried with the help of known cable operators. Short dramas by authors like Sri M.S.Prakasa Rao also may be telecast as extension of this activity.
10. Gemini TV channel does regular telecast of programmes on Bhagawan. However, the programmes prepared by Prasanthi Studio (with suitable restrictions incorporated for public viewing) may be supplied.
11. Other public activities suggested were:
  - Cultural programmes,
  - Public goodness boards,
  - Multi-faith prayers (to be attended by people from different religions),
  - Slogans by prominent individuals (to be kept in places like Tank Bund).
12. Yagna is to be organised preferably by mahilas in SSSVIP villages. This can be done by the service wing / spiritual wing. The activity has to be co-ordinated by the Dist. President.
13. Discussions on specific topics may be recorded and sent to Radio Channels like Radio Mirchi/ Red FM. (Cost is to be ascertained).
14. The best samithi which implemented the action plan is to be awarded.
15. Public Activities committee should meet once in 4 months.
16. Any new ideas are welcome to be brought to the notice of the PAC convener Sri D Vishnu Vardhan Rao.
17. The following points were presented by brother Y Srinivasa Rao:
  - (a) How to organise media meet involving Senior correspondents and media heads.
  - (b) SSSSO should be proactive – contact persons and district level media coordinator should be named in every district to help communication between SSSSO and the media.
  - (c) Only designated persons to speak to the media –some guidelines
  - (d) Reporting format shall be finalised before the next state meeting.
18. Sri Ram Prasad called for programmes which are inspiring (quality rather than quantity). He also suggested the introduction of low-priced books and starting of public activities first in villages.
19. Sri SG Chalam, SP, SSSSO, AP mentioned that any activity taken up by the Organisation is to be informed to the PAC of the district. He also advised the PAC to extend help and support to the District Organisation in the implementation of planned programmes.

With the divine blessings of swami the meeting to finalize the modalities for Seva Activities was finalized with the following suggestions.

1. It was decided to induct a minimum of 8 to 10 trained ASMs per district along with the district office bearers of all the wings. They will actively get involved in the implementation of the action plan.
2. Youth wing both Gents and Mahila will henceforth take active role in mobilizing & motivating youth, while actively participating in various activities enlisted under the action plan.
3. All the participants present in to days subcommittee meeting will join hands together in implementation of action plan at the gross root level in every district.
4. It was decided to extend a roaster /calendar for all the Conveners from Bhajan mandali level including youth for the Prasanthinilayam Services once a year
5. It was suggested to conduct awareness camps for disaster management at College level, in districts.
6. It was suggested to hold integrated medical services in all districts with a focus on cancer detection camps, blood donation camps and uni-specialty camps once a year.
7. While participating in Seva at temples / holy places governed by endowment department it was decided to seek official clearance from the EO of the concerned place.
